PROPER:

Introit Psalm: Give sentence with me O God, and defend the cause of my soul against the ungodly people: **deliver me and rid me from the deceitful and wicked man, for thou O Lord art my God and my strong salvation.** O send out thy light and thy truth that they may lead me: **and bring me unto thy holy hill and to thy dwelling.** Give sentence with me O God... etc.

Gradual: Deliver me O Lord from mine enemies: **teach me to do the thing that pleaseth thee.** It is the Lord that delivereth me from my cruel enemies, and setteth me up above mine adversaries: **thou shalt deliver me from the wicked man.**

Tract: Many a time have they fought against me: from my youth up, **may Israel now say: yea many a time have they vexed me from my youth up.** But they have not prevailed against me: The plowers ploughed upon my back. **And made long furrows: but the righteous Lord hath hewn the snares of the ungodly in pieces.**

Offertory Psalm: I will give thanks unto the Lord with my whole heart: O do well unto thy servant that may live and keep thy word: **quicken thou me according to thy name O Lord.**

Communion Psalm: This is my Body which is given for you; this Cup is the new Testament in my blood saith the Lord: **this do ye as oft as ye drink it in remembrance of me.**
