Introit Psalm: I am risen and am still with thee alleluia; Thou hast laid thine hand upon me alleluia: **thy knowledge is too wonderful and excellent for me, alleluia alleluia.** O Lord thou hast searched me out and known me: **thou knowest my down sitting and mine uprising.** Glory be...and to the Holy Ghost: **As it was in the beginning is now and ever shall be world without end Amen. I am risen and am still with thee** etc....

Gradual: This is the day which the Lord hath made: **we will be joyful and glad in it.** O give thanks unto the Lord for he is gracious: **and his mercy endureth for ever.**
