S. Michael's Food Bank Box

The Exeter Food Bank needs in-date donations of the following items to provide a balanced diet:

- Potatoes (tinned or powdered)
- Fish (especially tinned tuna)
- Loo rolls and Basic Toiletries
- Milk - 1 litre semi-skimmed UHT
- Meat (tinned - especially Fray Bentos pies)
- Sponge puddings (the microwave ones)
- Nappies, sizes 4, 5 and 6

The Food Bank fed 196 people during Holy Week and gave away about 300 Easter Eggs
This past Thursday alone, it served 137 people (a record number) in a single day.
Its number of volunteers is reduced as many are in high-risk groups (e.g. over 70)
