PROPER:

Introit Psalm: But as for us it behoveth us to glory in the Cross of our Lord Jesus Christ: in whom is our salvation our life and resurrection, by whom we were saved and obtained our freedom. God be merciful unto us and bless us: and show us the light of his countenance and be merciful unto us. But as for us... etc.

Gradual: Christ became obedient for our sakes unto death: even the death of the Cross. Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him: and given him the Name which is above every name

Offertory Psalm: The right hand of the Lord hath the pre-eminence; the right hand of the Lord bringeth mighty things to pass: I shall not die but live and declare the works of the Lord

Communion Psalm: The Lord Jesus after he had supped with his disciples and had washed their feet said unto them: **Know ye what your Lord and Master have done to you ? I have given you an example that ye should do as I have done unto you**

Mass proceeds as normal until the Post-Communion Prayer. Then the Blessed Sacrament is carried reverently to the Altar of Repose, accompanied by the singing of the hymn 'Of the Glorious Body telling' (NEH **268**). During the final two verses, the celebrant and servers prostrate before the Altar of Repose and cense the Sacrament. The sanctuary is then stripped of its furnishings, while is sung:

Antiphon: They parted my garments among them; **and upon my vesture did they cast lots.**

followed by Psalm 22,

followed by repetition of the Antiphon.

All depart in silence.

A watch is kept until midnight before the Altar of Repose, in which all are welcome to participate
