Introit Psalm: Consider O Lord and hear me when I cry unto thee: **be thou my succour O cast me not away, neither forsake me utterly O God of my salvation.** The Lord is my light and my salvation: whom then shall I fear? Glory be..and to the Holy Ghost: As it was... and ever shall be: world without end. Amen. Consider O Lord... etc.
