Introit Psalm: Haste thee O God unto my rescue and save me, O Lord make haste to my deliverance: **let mine enemies be ashamed and confounded that seek after my soul.** Let them be turned backward and put to confusion: **that wish me evil.** Glory be... and to the Holy Ghost, **As it was... and ever shall be: world without end. Amen. Haste thee O God... etc.**

Gradual and Alleluia: I will always give thanks unto the Lord; **his praise shall ever be in my mouth.** My soul shall make her boast in the Lord: **the humble shall hear thereof and be glad.** Alleluia. **Alleluia.** O come let us sing unto the Lord: **let us heartily rejoice in the strength of our salvation.
